
Falling Dominoes of Destruction


Lies believed – broken love and trust

Fear & selfishness – destructive acts (sins)


 Destructive acts (sins) – damage to mind, character and body, a terminal condition







- 1. Think for yourself
 - Isaiah 1:18-20, John 15:15, Romans 14:5, Hebrews 5:14
- Establish trust in God based on evidence
 - John 6:29, Matthew 11:2-5, Luke 24:13-27
- 3. Form beliefs based on evidence, truth & facts
 - John 8:32
- 4. Evaluate feelings in light of evidence
 - James 1:13,14
- 5. Control the imagination (eliminate punitive God concept)
 - Jeremiah 11:18
- Establish healthy religious practices (meditate on loving God concept)
 - Exodus 20:3-7, 2 Cor 3:18, Isa 1:10-20
- 7. Choose to do what is right, healthy, loving and reasonable because it is right healthy and reasonable
 - Joshua 24:15
